PWVTA ANNUAL MEETING AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Nominees: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Secretary.

PRESIDENT: Maggi Peyton Maggi has lived in 784 Columbus Avenue since 1964. She has been active in the Park West Village Tenants' Association since its inception and was president during the early days of PWVTA. She organized the community fight to stop the narrowing of 97th Street, worked on the successful fight to prevent a hardship increase in 1978, and was involved with the successful Warranty of Habitability effort by the PWVTA to ensure that tenants were provided healthy, sanitary conditions, and if these were not provided by the landlord the tenants could withhold rent. Maggi is currently the President of the PWVTA.

VICE PRESIDENT: Albina De Meio Resident of PWV in 788 Columbus Avenue since 1979. Starting in 2000 she assisted with the investigations and submissions to DHCR for the initial 25 rent-overcharge cases. When development began on the PWV property, she chaired the PWVTA Alternative Design Sub-Committee. The committee prepared a counter-proposal for the development of the property that would complement the original PWV planned community. As with many PWVTA members, she participated in forums relating to the development of 'Columbus Square', the CB7 Construction Committee and the PVW Coordinating Group. She has served as a Building Representative and Chair of the Quality of Life Committee.

TREASURER: Jane Bender Resident of PWV since 1971. Served as Building Representative for 784 Columbus Ave. Member of Park West Community Network. Previously Floor Captain. Profession: Social Worker. Currently employed part-time by Big Brothers/Big Sisters of New York, assessing new volunteers. Elected 2010 PWVTA Treasurer.

SECRETARY: Gloria Scorse Gloria has lived in Park West Village since July, 1969. During the years that her sons were in public school, she was active in the parents' associations of P.S. 84 and Joan of Arc Junior High School. Since her retirement as a teacher, she has volunteered for the American Museum of Natural History and the Central Park Conservancy. Served as a Building Rep from 392 CPW. She is currently the Secretary for the PWVTA.

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY: Miriamne Spector 372 Central Park West. Miriamne has been a resident of PWV since 1975 and is a long-time active member of PWVTA. She has served as a building rep and is currently the Membership Secretary. She believes that we need a strong organization in place in order to deal with both day-to-day problems as they come up and the longer term issues that we continue to pursue, such as maintenance of affordable housing and the quality of life in our neighborhood.
